We can confirm that no COVID patients were redirected from any hospitals in England to hospitals in Dumfries and Galloway for treatment.

Not applicable, as the answer to question 1 was nil.

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During the period 1 December 2020 and 11 January 2021, 8 patients who were emergency admissions who were COVID positive and who had a postcode on or near the border with Carlisle or CA postcode and of the 8 less than 5 of these patients had at least one spell in ICU during their stay - these were admissions from a private residence or holiday accommodation so were not transfers. This does not necessarily mean they were re-directed, as this level of detail is not something the Health Board holds.
