

How many 80-year-olds and over in the health board area have turned down the vaccine and how many have been vaccinated in total (come the end of January)?

At the end of January a total of 8,471 vaccines had been administered to people over the age of 80 in the community. A further 195 vaccines were administered to people in this age group on 1 February, bringing the total number of vaccines administered to 8,666.

The Health Board does not have a specific record of over 80s who reside in care homes but have estimated to be approximately 700.

Data regarding those over 80 who have declined the vaccine is not held in a reportable or centralised format; therefore this request is refused under section 17 of FOISA
