

1. The estimated population within the Health Board area of each of the JCVI priority groups for the COVID-19 vaccination. For the avoidance of doubt these are:

- Residents and workers in care homes for older people.
- All those over 80 years of age and over.
- Patient facing, frontline healthcare workers.
- Non-clinical but patient facing staff in secondary or primary care/community healthcare settings.
- Laboratory and pathology staff
- Social care staff directly involved in the care of their service users and others involved directly in delivering social care such that they and vulnerable patients/clients are at increased risk of exposure.
- all those 75 years of age and over
- all those 70 years of age and over and clinically extremely vulnerable individuals
- all those 65 years of age and over
- all individuals aged 16 years to 64 years with underlying health conditions which put them at higher risk of serious disease and mortality and Unpaid carers
- all those 60 years of age and over
- all those 55 years of age and over
- all those 50 years of age and over
- All JCVI Groups

The Scottish Government are working with Public Health Scotland and NHS Education for Scotland to finalise the population estimates for each JCVI priority group including breakdowns by health board. As outlined in the [COVID-19 Vaccine Deployment Plan 2021](#), the national estimates published in Table 1 are indicative and subject to ongoing review and quality assurance. More detail on these estimates are provided in the [vaccinations data technical note](#). An update, including population estimates by health board, will be published shortly once the work to finalise these estimates concludes.
